




(Kohs & Company O Scale Production Model Shown Above)

Our project will consist of UP 4664-3, 4 & 5 class locomotives in six (6) basic versions plus the Rio Grande L-97 units and the single-stack Clinchfield E-3's. Although there are eight (8) basic versions listed below, there are actually fourteen (14) model variations as a result of the unique characteristics and details commonly associated with specific road numbers and production groups, all of these will be properly modeled based on the specific models chosen by future owners for production. Version #1 'Early Coal' - Black overall, Graphite smokebox and firebox with Aluminum color markings

Version #2 Coal 3967 with smoke lifters - Black overall, Graphite smokebox and firebox with Aluminum color markings

Version #3 'Late Coal' - Black overall, Graphite smokebox and firebox with Aluminum color markings

Version #4 'Early Oil Fired' - Black overall, Graphite smokebox and firebox with Aluminum color markings

Version #5 'Passenger Paint Scheme - Two-tone Gray paint scheme with Silver-Gray striping

Version #6 'Late Oil Fired' - Black overall, Graphite smokebox and firebox with Aluminum color markings

Version #7 'Rio Grande' - Black overall, Graphite smokebox and firebox with White markings and trim

Version #8 'Clinchfield' - Black overall, Graphite smokebox and firebox with Yellow markings
